



General Practitioner Role

Initial Care Plan

- Complete Full Health Assessment with client
- Assess whether client fits eligibility for NCACCH chronic disease management program and complete relevant Care Plan
- Give a copy of the Care Plan to the client and forward a copy to the clients Care Coordinator / NCACCH
- Duty of Care to refer client to appropriate Allied Health Service Providers that bulk bill for full treatment
- Close consultation with the Care Coordinator in regards to the clients progress

Review by GP

- The GP reviews the initial care plan
- Considers whether the arrangements for treatment, service and care have been carried out
- Considers whether different arrangements need to be made to achieve the management goals mentioned in the plan
- If different arrangements need to be made, prepare a revised care plan, stating those arrangements
- The review of the plan must also include:
 - Discussing the review of the care plan with the Care Coordinator
 - Give copies of relevant parts of the revised plan to the Care Coordinator and to persons who, under the plan, will give the patient the treatment, service and care mentioned in the care plan
