Bulk Billing Doctors


To be bulk billed with a doctor, present your current NCACCH Health Access Card with your Medicare Card at any of our participating General Practitioner locations. A current list of NCACCH GP Practices can be found on our website: ncacch.org.au

Allied Health Services

To access an Allied Health Service, you will require a Referral that is issued by NCACCH or a NCACCH Referrer. NCACCH provides Allied Health visits* to:

- Dental
- Mental Health
- Dietitian/Nutrition
- Podiatry
- Physiotherapy

*There are limits on the amount you can spend each financial year.

MEDICAL SERVICE

To be bulk billed at the Aboriginal Medical Service, you will require a NCACCH Health Access Card that is issued by NCACCH or a NCACCH Referrer.

The Aboriginal Medical Service provides bulk billed access to:

- Doctors
- Aboriginal Health Workers
- Clinical Nurses
- Health Checks (715)
- Chronic Disease Management
- Child and Maternal Health
- Women's Health
- Immunizations and Vaccinations
- Tackling Indigenous Smoking
- Transport*

*There is an eligibility criteria for access to transport.
