HOW THE PROGRAM CAN HELP YOU:

The NCACCH Mum's & Bub's Program provides women and their families with confidential and culturally appropriate support.

This program will provide you with a Midwife who will work closely with you, your Doctor and other community services, to help you access the range of services you may need.

Your Midwife can:

Provide one on one support

Meet at a suitable place of your choice eg antenatal clinic, park, cafe etc

Support you during pregnancy, until baby is one year old

Connect you with other programs eg playgroup, Jabba Jabba, NCACCH Tackling Indigenous Smoking, BUMPS Program etc

Support the health and wellbeing of you and your family
